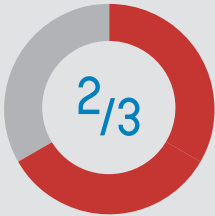

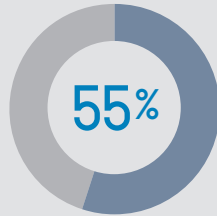


Integrated Youth Services (IYS) offers easily accessible points of care in the community that provide rapid access to quality and youth-appropriate services.

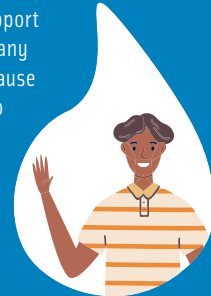

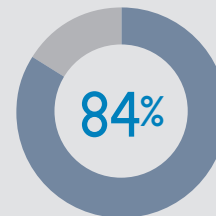

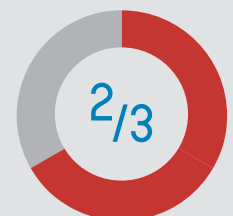

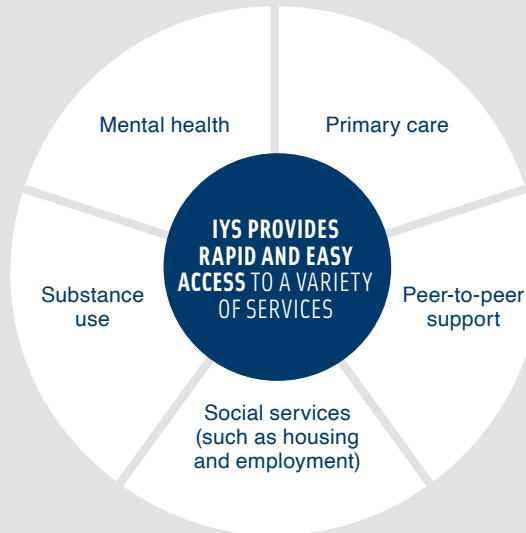

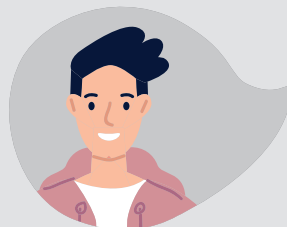
